**[REVISED] CYBERSECURITY ADVISORY**  
**6 ESSENTIAL MEASURES TO BE SAFE ONLINE**

**OVERVIEW**

Singapore Health Services (SingHealth) database containing patient personal particulars and outpatient medication data has been the target of a major cyberattack. Investigations confirmed that this was a deliberate, targeted and well-planned cyberattack. It was not the work of casual hackers or criminal gangs.

2 The Integrated Health Information System (IHIS)<sup>1</sup> has implemented further measures to tighten the security of SingHealth's IT systems. These include temporarily imposing internet surfing separation. We have also placed additional controls on workstations and servers, reset user and systems accounts, and installed additional system monitoring controls. Similar measures are being put in place for IT systems across the public healthcare sector against this threat.

3 All licensees under the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics Act (PHMCA) are strongly advised to heighten vigilance, strengthen monitoring controls, and review your cyber security policies to regularly protect your IT systems against the evolving cybersecurity threat.

4 This advisory provides information on how you can protect your IT systems and infrastructure against cyber threats.

**6 ESSENTIALS TO DEFEND AGAINST CYBER ATTACKS**

5 In order to better assist your business to defend against any cyber-attacks, the Cyber Security Agency of Singapore (CSA) has identified 13 integrated cybersecurity measures, of which the top six are termed 'Essentials'.

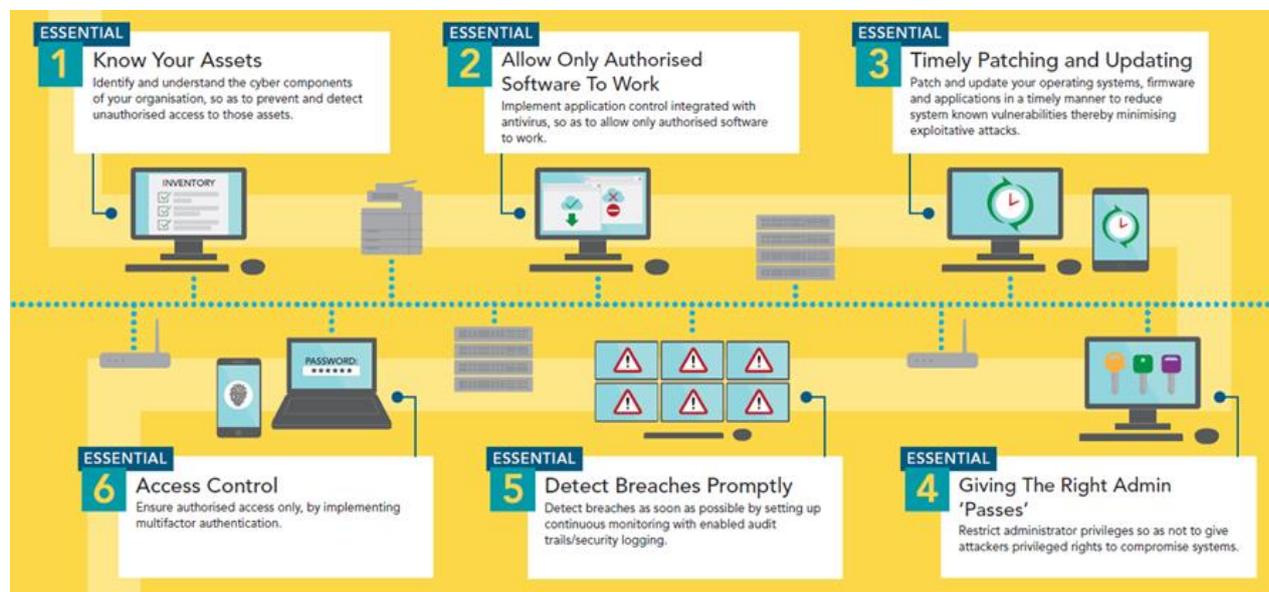
